Opening October 9, 2021, the Ice House Gallery and its curator Brandt Eisner are presenting some of Canada's most recognized potters in an exhibit that chronicles the most exciting work happening in pottery today.

Unified Earth includes more than a dozen potters from various geographies and walks of life. Each potters' work challenges our expectations of what pottery is capable of and pushes the boundaries of conversation in the field of ceramics and more.

In an age of pandemic anxiety, we search to examine a new appreciation for the functional/ aesthetic object in lives more and more confined to the home. The ways that sculpted objects, functional or observed, add depth and meaning to lives limited by pandemic restrictions. How do these objects bring joy and meaning to our everyday lives? *Unified Earth* does not aim to answer the question, but instead supply ample evidence through pottery to the joy of owning both functional and aesthetic work.
